Living the Blessed Life

1. Living the blessed life has nothing to do with your temporary circumstances!
 - “mourn” - “persecuted”
 - “revile you and speak evil against you falsely”

Living the Blessed Life

2. Living the blessed life is based upon a long term eternal perspective.

- vs. 3 & 10 – “kingdom of heaven”
- vs. 8 – “shall see God”
- vs. 12 – “...great is your reward...”


Living the Blessed Life

3. Living the blessed life is based upon the development of internal Christ-like character.
 - vs. 3 – “poor in spirit”
 - vs. 5 – “meek”
 - vs. 6,7,8, & 9

4. Living the blessed life is based upon our international and global evangelical inheritance.
 - vs. 5 – “blessed are the meek for they shall inherit the earth.”
 - Revelation 11:15
