





Pray for God's provision over you, your family, your church. Be specific. Be tenacious. Believe it is God's will to prosper you!

4. "FORGIVES US OUR DEBTS, AS WE FORGIVE OUR DEBTORS."

Ask God to forgive you of any sin. Set your will to be a forgiver.

5. "LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION, BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL"

a. Put on the whole armor of God in prayer.

- put on the breastplate of righteousness
- put on the ready shoes of the gospel of peace.
- take up the shield of faith.
- take up the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God.
- b. Pray a hedge of protection over yourself, your family & your church.
