DISCOVER YOUR MOTIVATIONAL GIFT (Rom 12:3-8)

- 1. **PROPHECY** -The motivation to reveal the true nature of man by speaking God's truth through love.
- 2. **SERVING** The motivation to demonstrate love by meeting practical needs.
- 3. **TEACHING** The motivation to search out and validate truth which has been presented.
- 4. **EXHORTATION** The motivation to stimulate and build up the faith of others.
- 5. **GIVING** The motivation to entrust personal assets to others for the expansion of God's kingdom in the earth.
- 6. **LEADERSHIP** The motivation to coordinate and administrate the activities of others for the achievement of kingdom purposes.
- 7. **MERCY** The motivation to identify with and bring comfort to those who are in distress.

Every believer normally moves and operates through **ONE** primary motivational gift.

Notice 1 Peter 4:10 is singular in number.

"...as every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another."

All believers will perform all seven activities but normally through one basic motivation.
