Habakkuk 2:1-3

“I will stand my watch and set myself on the rampart, and watch to see what He will say to me and what I will answer when I am corrected. Then the Lord answered me and said, ‘Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time; but at the end it will speak and it will not lie. Though it tarries, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.’ ”

Visionary Statements

- ***The visions completion demands our determined participation.***
- ***“...I will...”***
- ***The hearing ear requires the seeing eye.***
- ***“I will watch to see what He will say to me...”***

Visionary Focal Points

- ***A. Clarity of the Vision***
- ***1. Requires correction***
- ***The wrong lens***
- ***Denial***
- ***Defeat***
- ***Delusion***

A. Clarity of the Vision

- ***2. Requires new perspective***
- ***“STAND” – position of better perspective.***
- ***“TOWER” – position of even greater perspective***

A. Clarity of the Vision

- ***3. Requires proper positioning.***
- ***“I will stand my watch”***
- ***- Sentry – one who guards the wall***
- ***- Can't be out of position!***

B. Commitment to the Vision

- 1. To STAND – to take ownership of our corporate responsibility.***
- 2. To STAY – “set myself”***
- 3. To SECURE – “...Write...”***
- 4. To SHARE – “...run...”***
