1 Peter 1:1-9

- Review...
- Written to persecuted Jewish believers who had been scattered.
- Pilgrims – temporary residents
- Spiritual progress requires a mental and moral shift from the temporal to the eternal.

Starting Blocks...

- The Resurrection – vs. 2
- Spiritual progress requires a revelation of the resurrection
- Matthew 16
- John 20 & 21
- 1 Corinthians 15:17-20

Revelation Release

- Total Restoration – vs. 3
- Eternal Destination – vs. 3,4
 - 1 Peter 4:12,13
 - Romans 8:18
- Powerful Protection
 - kept = guarded or protected
 - power = H. S. power

Revelation Release

- Grievous but Glorious Confirmation – vs. 7,8
- The journey is a test
- Passing the test
- LOVE
- BELIEVE
- RECEIVE – to carry

Revelation Release

- Joyous Exaltation
- vs. 3 – “Blessed be...”
- vs. 6-8
- A lack of joy is a lack of faith.
- “greatly rejoice” & “rejoice with joy” – jump for joy
