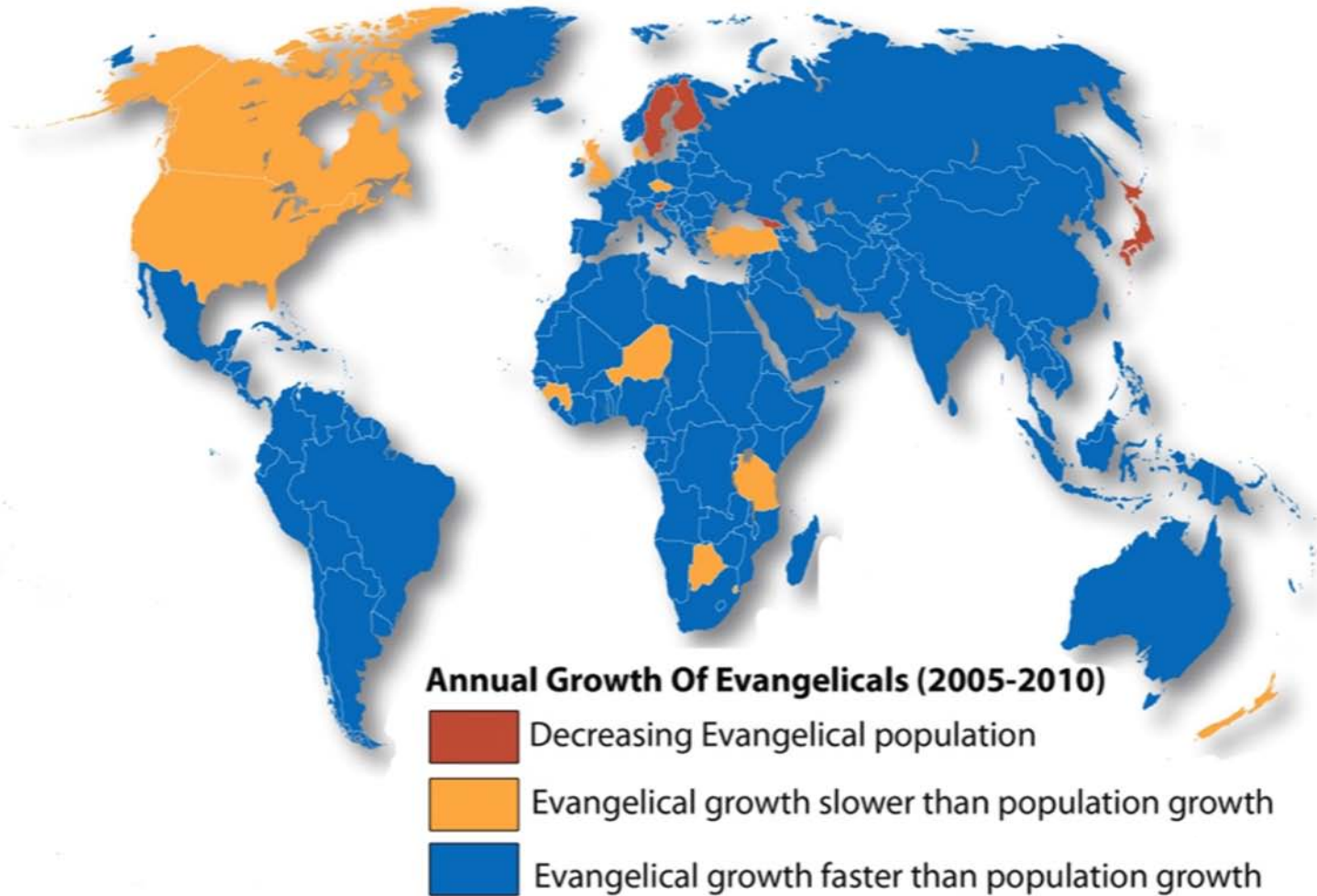
- A church wide campaign to raise the bar of our personal commitment to...

On Any Given Sunday

- Less than 50% of “active” members will be in attendance.
- Only 10-25% of members will tithe.
- Only 50% of attendees will have shared the gospel in past 12 months.
- 25% of church going married women will attend without their husbands.
- 70% of boys will abandon church in their teens or twenties.
- Only 1 out of 6 Christian men will attend church on any given Sunday.
