Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

- 2 Kings 18:1-7
- Historical Context - Divided Kingdom
 - - Israel - Hoshea - 2 Kings 17
 - - Judah - Hezekiah - 2 Kings 18
- Rewind - Hezekiah was son of Ahaz
- 2 Chronicles 28:1-5

Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

1. Held fast to a strong biblical understanding of right & wrong.
 - Vs. 4 - removed idol worship
 - Exodus 20 - 10 Commandments
 - Where did his moral compass come from? - vs. 2 - Abi & Zechariah

Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

2. Held fast to his personal relationship with God and his commitment of obedient trust in the Lord God.
 - Vs. 5 & 6
 - Wasn't riding anyone's spiritual coattails!

Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

3. Held fast to a strong personal responsibility to restore Judah to her godly heritage.
 - 2 Chronicles 29
 - Lived with a sense of prophetic destiny

Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

4. Held fast to his leadership responsibilities in the midst of overwhelming adversity.
 - 2 Kings 18:29-36
 - Sennacherib's endeavored to undermine their trust in God.

Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

5. Held fast to his understanding of the prophetic anointing.

- 2 Kings 19:1-7
- We need a Word from God!
- Example - Jehoshaphat - 2 Chron. 20

Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

5. Held fast to the place of prayer.

- 2 Kings 19:15-19
- Prayer of Reverence - vs. 15
- Prayer of Reliance - vs. 16
- Prayer of Request - vs. 19
- Prayer of Response - vs. 20 & 35-37

Training in Trusting - Hezekiah

6. Held fast in the face of death.
 - 2 Kings 20
 - It pays great dividends when we put our total trust in the Lord God!
 - 2 Kings 18:5-7
