

# Faithfulness

Galatians 5:22-23 Exodus 20



(Interpreted by the Gospel)

- 1. We are to know and trust God as the only true and living God.
- 2. We must avoid all idolatry and not worship God improperly.
- 3. We must treat God's name with fear and reverence, honoring also his Word and works.

(Interpreted by the Gospel)

4. That on one day a week, preferably and traditionally on Sundays, we spend time in public and private worship, rest from routine employment, serve the Lord and others, and thus anticipate the eternal Sabbath.

(Interpreted by the Gospel)

- 5. We are to love and honor our father and mother, submitting to their godly discipline and direction.
- 6. We are not to hurt, hate, or be hostile towards our neighbor, but be patient and peaceful, pursuing even our enemies with love.

7. We are to abstain from sexual immorality and live purely and faithfully, whether in marriage or in single life, avoiding all impure actions, looks, words, thoughts, and desires, and whatever might lead to them.

- 8. We should never take without permission that which belongs to someone else, nor withhold any good from someone we might benefit.
- 9. We should not lie or deceive, but speak the truth in love.

(Interpreted by the Gospel)

10. We must be content, not envying anyone or resenting what God has given them or us.

## The New Covenant

Jeremiah 31:31-34

... I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts...

Ezekiel 36:26-27

... give you a new heart ... And I will put my Spirit within you so that you will follow my decrees and be careful to obey my regulations.

## The New Covenant

Jeremiah 32:38-40

I will put a desire in their hearts to worship me, and they will never leave me.

Ezekiel 11:19-20

I will ... give them a heart of flesh, that they may walk in my statutes and keep my rules and obey them.
