In scripture, commitments were made between men, as well as between God and man. We call these commitments covenants. God was the originator of covenants.





Six Keys to Praying the Model Prayer Matthew 6:9-13

1. "OUR FATHER IN HEAVEN, HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME"

Spend time affirming the Fatherhood of God in your life.

Romans 8:15 - "...you have received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, Abba, Father." Spend time praising God and appropriating the benefit of His names. Psalm 100:4 - "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and into His courts with praise..."

Pray for God's provision over you, your family, and your church. Be specific. Be tenacious. Believe it is God's will to prosper you!

4. "FORGIVES US OUR DEBTS, AS WE FORGIVE OUR DEBTORS."

Ask God to forgive you of any sin. Set your will to be a forgiver.

5. "LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION, BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL"

a. Put on the whole armor of God in prayer. Ephesians 6:10-18

- put on the belt of truth
- put on the breastplate of righteousness
- put on the ready shoes of the gospel of peace.
- take up the shield of faith.
- take up the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God.

b. Pray a hedge of protection over yourself, your family & your church.
