A SPIRITUAL GIFT: a special ability or abilities, given by the Holy Spirit to every believer used to minister to others and therefore, build up the Body of Christ.

C) INSPIRATION GIFTS - Gifts that _____ something.

(Supernatural utterances of the spirit through a person for the purposes of edification, exhortation and comfort to the body of Christ.)
2. _____
(Supernatural utterances of the spirit in a language not learned or understood by the speaker.)
3. _____ of tongues.
(Supernatural insight, understanding, and declaration of a message in tongues.)

APPLYING MY ABILITIES

COTR NORTH MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

GREETERS: As part of our welcoming/fellowship team, greeters welcome members and visitors to the regular and special services with a friendly greeting and a church bulletin. They assist head greeter by filling bulletins with special announcement inserts when requested.

MEDIA AND SOUND MINISTRY: A computer-oriented ministry team working to assist the pastoral and worship teams and the Praise Band to blend the instruments and voices and visually communicate truth through Power Point, multimedia presentations and internet communication. In addition, this team records the services for the audio/visual ministry to publish or duplicate for the church.

PRAISE BAND: A group of rhythm musicians such as a pianist, keyboardist, bassist, guitarist, and drummer who form the foundation of our worship service.

USHERS: Working with other ushers during our church services to seat the members. They help with the offering, distributing envelopes and offering containers. Distribute first time visitor cards. Help prepare and serve communion on Communion Sunday.

HOSPITALITY: This on-going ministry provides meals for members when there is a funeral, illness, or birth. Volunteers prepare and deliver food to homes or designated sites.

HOUSEKEEPING/GROUNDS: Volunteers will work under the direction of our facilities staff to assist in the cleaning and maintenance of our building and grounds.

YOUTH SPONSOR: Those adults who would be able to help the Youth Pastor oversee the various activities and functions in which the teens participate.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH: These opportunities include numerous outreaches to nursing homes, the needy as well as ministry in the local city parks and other venues.

CONNECT GROUPS: This ministry involves providing a home atmosphere for small groups to meet for the purpose of fellowship, worship, prayer and the ministry of the Word.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

NURSERY: (Birth - 23 months) Nursery care is available for all services. The nursery workers emphasize love, teaching and caring, as the primary goal and priority.

TWO'S AND THREE'S MINISTRY: These classes are normally offered for both age groups at all service times. Baby-sitting is kept to a minimum and teaching to a maximum as the teachers and assistants teach curriculum created to build lasting foundations in our younger children.

PRE-SCHOOL MINISTRY: Classes for the four and five year olds are taught the word of God by trained teachers and assistants using Bible lessons, flannel graphs, hands-on activities, puppets, stories, music and much more. Classes are on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights, with the exception of the 1st Sunday of each month when the children stay in "Big Church" with their parents.

KID'S CHURCH: (1st - 6th Grades) Kid's Church on Sundays and classes on Wednesdays provide Bible teaching from Genesis to Revelation. Training kids in God's word and Bible memorization is a priority. Music, puppets, object lessons, drama and games make Kid's Church a fun and exciting place to be. Ministry is a must as well as teaching children to minister to one another.

EASTER OUTREACH: The Saturday before Easter or following the Easter Sunday Service, the children's ministry hosts a community wide Easter Egg Outreach. Every year, children and adults alike are presented the gospel in a simple and relevant way with many making commitments to Christ.

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL: VBS is a week every summer that kids really look forward to. Each year creative volunteers work together, decorating, planning, and preparing to develop a week kids will always remember.

KID'S CAMP: Each summer's highlight is Kid's Camp! It is designed for kids who have graduated 1st grade and kids through 6th grade. Each year's theme is always prayed over and carefully planned. The camp is designed to create non-stop fun, activities, recreation, crafts, and great Bible teaching with dramas, puppets, object lessons and so much more. Camp counselors take part in helping teach as well as care for the kids. Our goals are to provide not only fun, but also quality teaching and to equip the kids with tools they need to grow mighty in God!
